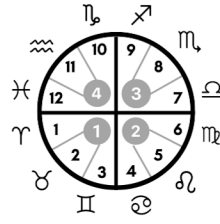

 4th Quadrant: Social Identity









Astrological Terms

Understanding Common Terms



Transits

Transits refer to the current positions of the planets in the sky and how they are impacting an individual's natal chart.

These planetary movements can activate different areas of a person's life, bringing new opportunities or challenges. They are circumstances outside the individual's control.

Aspects

Aspects in astrology refer to the angles formed between two planets or between a planet and a sensitive point in a natal chart, such as the Ascendant or Midheaven. Aspects are believed to have a significant influence on the interpretation of a chart and can indicate the nature of the relationship between the planets involved.

Zodiac Sign

The Zodiac signs are the twelve constellations that the Sun passes through during its annual journey across the sky.

Each sign is associated with specific personality traits and characteristics, based on the positions of the stars and planets at the time of a person's birth.

Points

Points refer to a specific position in the sky. They are used to determine the astrological significance of certain celestial bodies or angles, such as the ascendant, midheaven, or lunar nodes. They are calculated based on the positions of the planets, signs, and houses in a birth chart, and are often used to interpret the individual's personality traits, life experiences, and future events.

Cusp

The boundary between two signs or houses in an astrological chart

Modalities

The three basic modes of expression, cardinal, fixed, and mutable, which are associated with the zodiac signs and indicate different ways of taking action and approaching challenges.

Elements

The four basic energies of fire, earth, air, and water that are associated with the zodiac signs and indicate different qualities and tendencies.

Polarity

Polarity refers to the relationship between two opposite zodiac signs, such as Aries and Libra, which are opposite signs and have opposite qualities

Duality

Duality refers to the concept of masculine and feminine energies present in the signs, which can also be referred to as the active and receptive energies respectively.

Progressions

Progressions refer to the gradual evolution of a person's natal chart over time. By advancing the positions of the planets at a symbolic rate, progressions reveal how a person's inner world is evolving and changing over time. The individual can have control over these changes.

Planetary Movements

Planetary movements in astrology refer to the changing positions of planets in relation to the Earth, as viewed from the Earth's perspective. This includes direct and retrograde motion, as well as planetary ingress and egress into different zodiac signs. These movements are significant in astrology as they can have an impact on individual horoscopes and can be used to make astrological predictions.

House

House refers to one of the 12 sections of the zodiac that represent different areas of a person's life. Each house is associated with a specific zodiac sign and planetary ruler, and its position in a person's birth chart can indicate various aspects of their personality, experiences, and life events.

Natal Chart

The Moon also has an impact on the tides of the ocean, and many believe that it affects our physical bodies as well. It is associated with the element of water and is said to have a feminine energy.

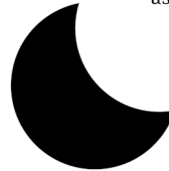
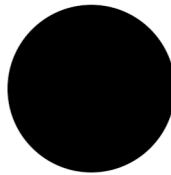
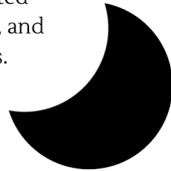

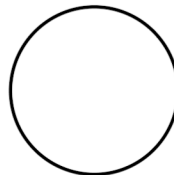
Third Quarter

This is the beginning of the lunar cycle, and it represents a time of new beginnings, fresh starts, and setting intentions.



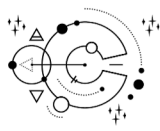
Decans



A decan is a subdivision of each zodiac sign into three equal parts of 10 degrees each. Each decan has its own planetary ruler and unique characteristics. 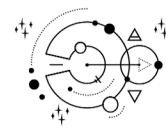

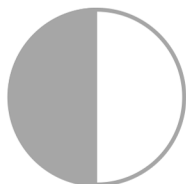

Ascendant (aka Rising Sign)	The degree of the elliptic rising over the eastern horizon at the moment of birth	Reflects your outward personality, appearance, and the way you interact with the world.
Descendant	The degree of the elliptic that is setting below the western horizon at the moment of birth	Represents the qualities and characteristics you seek in others, especially in close relationships and partnerships.
Midheaven (Medium Coeli)	The degree of the zodiac that is at the top of the sky at the moment of birth	Represents your aspirations, goals, and ambitions in the outer world.
Imum Coeli (IC)	The point in the sky immediately beneath us at the moment of birth	Represents your innermost emotional core, your private life, and your deepest sense of self
North Node	A point where the Moon intercepts northern ecliptic hemisphere	Symbolizes the direction and lessons we are meant to embrace in this lifetime
South Node	Where the Moon intercepts southern ecliptic hemisphere	Signifies the qualities and tendencies we may rely on too heavily or need to release in order to evolve.
Chiron	A half-comet and half-asteroid. It's position on the chart at the time of birth is significant.	Represents our deepest wounds, as well as our potential for healing and growth.
Lilith (Lunar Apogee)	The point in the Moon's orbit that is farthest from the Earth.	Sheds light on areas where one may feel suppressed or yearn for greater freedom and self-expression.

The eastern hemisphere represents the self and personal development. Planets located in the eastern hemisphere suggest a focus on self-expression, individuality, and personal goals.

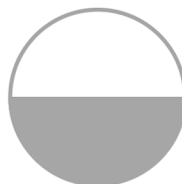
